The Next Step

January 9th was a very exciting day for us for two reasons. The first of which being that we found out that our application for full-time missionary staff had been accepted by the camp board. Andy has been filling the hospitality position as a resident since we arrived here in August 2016 and applied for it back in November. We are now starting the process of coming on as a full-time missionary staff and are hoping and praying to be close to, if not reach full support, by June 18th. The date of June 18th might sound ambitious but we know that God has called us to ministry here at camp. This process will take up much of our time, and we feel it is beneficial to be fully support before the start of summer camp, so we can focus our time on doing ministry and not being split between the two. At this moment, we are at 38% of our monthly total that we need.

The best way to explain going from being a resident to full-time missionary staff is that, as a resident, we were filling a need temporarily with no big commitment on ours or the camp's side. If someone else wanted, they could have applied for the position. Coming on as missionary staff, we are saying that we feel this is where God wants us to be doing ministry and we are committing to being here long term. The other major change is that, with that commitment, Andy will be given more responsibility with his roles, along with taking on new ones.

Arrival of Micah James


