The price of this six-day package is **\$1,175.00** per person for double occupancy. If you are single and would like to arrange for a roommate/double occupancy, please contact LLBC. If you would like to join us but prefer a single room, the single-occupancy rate is \$1,345.00.

The price includes admission to all featured attractions, transportation in a deluxe restroom-equipped motor coach, five nights' lodging in lovely hotels with hot breakfasts and baggage handling (*one suitcase per person, please*), our traditional first day box lunch, and one choice meal per day. Daily devotionals, snacks, the services of your tour hosts and bus driver, and lots of fun are the icing on the cake for our bus tours!

A **deposit of \$150** per person must accompany your registration form by October 1, with the balance due by October 15, 2023. After that date only half of your fee will be refunded should you need to cancel. The overnight fee for staying at Lake Lundgren the night before or after the trip (*should you need to*) is \$28.00 per person per night in a cabin with a bathroom. An overnight stay includes a cup of coffee and sweet bread to get you started for the day on Friday morning.

An email confirmation will be sent once we process your registration. A list of things to bring, a complete itinerary, health form, and invoice with current balance due will be sent to you around November 1st. Your tour hosts and nurse are Brad & Kim Nelson and Ruth Hryshkanych. They look forward to traveling with you.
