In early January registration for summer camp opened up online. Not surprisingly it filled up even quicker than last year. Since our last letter, camp has been in full swing with winter retreats. We've had a lot of guests over the past three months and not a lot of snow. Collin started working from 7am-4pm during the snow removal season, which was short. He went back to his normal hours mid-march (8-5). The maintenance team has been real busy with all kinds of projects around camp including remodeling the Den in the dining hall basement, moving logs for lumber and fire wood, and finishing up some small things with the bathhouse project. Also earlier this year we broke ground on a new duplex cabin project, its going to be built right next to silver maple and sugar maple. its going to be the first cabin building project camp has done in a while so please pray for us as we figure out all the planning and pacing for that project. on the smaller scale, we got a new air-compressor for in the maintenance building and it just arrived after an unusually long shipping time, so praise god its got finally here.

We praise God for a great winter season at camp in and for our family. Please continue to keep us in your prayers as we prepare for summer at camp and as we navigate the next season as a family.
